Ok to have a Volunteer Dock Assistant this season. Don Davis is working on a Job Description. Person will be required to sign a waiver of liability from the Town(?)

To gain some control of water use/ waste at the Comm Pier Larry will use a ball valve with lock and key for this season. 2 spigots need locks. Harbormaster will use discretion for billing for large tank filling (ex: boats mooring overnight)

Larry will contact the Water Dept for a meter to separate water and sewer use, which should help control cost.

The Town has a Permit by Rule to replace/ resurface the asphalt launch ramps. Looking for a company to resurface the current launch ramps. Earl at Public Works is researching this.

Seawall between the Rec and Commercial Piers is in rough shape. May need to implement Jersey Barriers this season. Wall is crumbling and unsafe.

We need an engineer study and cost estimate for the area, accounting for sea level rise. Dennis will contact Will Gartley.

WFC voted 3/0 to keep the Pier Vendor fees the same this season (2023).

Looking into spin dial electric meter to properly bill the Vendor at the Rec Pier. Larry will contact Ted

Susan will contact Ice Vendors and get information for a Ice Machine at the Rec Pier this season.
