

WISCASSET HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

21 September 2017

Chairman John Reinhardt called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members in attendance were Susan Blagden and Gordon Konrath. John asked Gordon to vote in place

Blagden moved and Konrath seconded to approve the minutes of 29 July 2017 and 7

Approval was unanimous.

COA for the Wiscasset Yacht Club to build a storage shed was considered. Blagden on record as being sorry about the proposed metal roof. Konrath moved for approval as presented, Reinhardt seconded. Unanimous.

COA for 40 Federal Street to build a 24' x 26' garage/barn in the back with asphalt roof and vinyl wood-look siding. Blagden moved for approval as presented, Konrath seconded. Unanimous.

Blagden said she wished all the people who were supposed to be unhappy with the HPC, as per the Selectmen Colby, Slack and Martin, would have the courtesy to come to the Hpc with their complaints.

Konrath said we should check with the Town Manager when the fees that they imposed are supposed to take effect.

Reinhardt said that we should try to get people to write the papers in support of the HPC Ordinance before the November referendum.

Blagden moved, seconded by Konrath, to schedule an informational open house meeting at 5 on 19th October with possible presentation by Lincoln County Historical Association and an historical preservation expert from Maine Preservation. Unanimous.
